### Contribution Rate Explanation

Each taxable employer is assigned a contribution rate once each year. The rate year begins on July 1st of the current calendar year. Rates are assigned in two ways. Rates for one or more calendar years following the year in which they first became eligible, that is, the first year of their experience. The calculations used to arrive at your rate appear in the boxes above. If an employer has not worked in Vermont for a sufficient period to have an "experience record", the contribution rate is one percent. NAICS construction codes 236, 237, or 238, shall have a contribution rate equal to the rate assigned. A "Foreign Corporation" is a corporation formed under the laws of another state or country. This determination is made in accordance with Title 21 of the Vermont Statutes Annotated, Sections 1324, 1326 and 1327. For more information, contact the Status Unit at (802) 828-4344.
